In 1947, the UN recommended dividing the land into an Arab state alongside a Jewish state. The lews accepted the compromise though it included only 13 percent of the land originally designated as the Jewish homeland. Arab and Palestinian leaders mobilized for war to prevent partition. "We are solidly and permanently determined to fight to the last man against the existence in our country of any lewish state, no matter how small it is." — Jamal al-Husseini, Palestinian leader
